

# Lifeguard Class – Important Information

- All class times and dates must be attended
- **One piece bathing suit for girls, regular suit (no cut offs) for boys**
- Goggles can be used for the pre course swim **BUT NOT THE BRICK RETRIEVAL**
- All skills, tests and requirements must be passed to receive certification
- Written tests must be passed with a minimum of 80%
- Be prepared: take notes, bring high lighter/pen to class
- Each day bring your suit/towel and be prepared for the water as well as class time. A change of clothes (rooms can be chilly), snack/drink etc.
- Use necessary precautions if you wear contacts, you can wear goggles for the pre course swim but not for the water skills (most people remove contacts)
- Keep possessions in your sight we are not responsible for lost items

Realizing this certification carries enormous responsibility: a student may not pass regardless of scores/skills if the general attitude, participation and maturity level are deemed insufficient by the instructor. Students will be issued a warning if their attitude is disruptive and/or uncooperative. It is the responsibility of the student to inform their parent/guardian if this situation occurs.

- Be prepared for the pre course swim. It is a good idea to swim prior to class if possible.
- Upon completion of the pre course swim we will distribute books and class materials. There will be homework/reading each time. Please make time to prepare for class.
